I have primarily pursued acting, but I have worked in every area of the theatre, including directing and stage management, which translates well into script supervision. Most notably, I stage managed a week-long Baroque theatre festival in the south of France in 2018. I have also directed in London, England, toured Canada as a stage manager while also acting on stage, and produced a pod-play experience in Paris and Prague. I have also worked on two theatre/film hybrid projects as theatre went digital during the pandemic. Both of those productions won multiple awards such as Critic's Pick (Hamilton Fringe) and The Production Award (Saskatoon and Area Theatre Awards).
